As part of a work experience scheme, I joined HYM Media for a week in late February 2013. My role at HYM included website design and development, providing clients with creative website solutions for their businesses and organisations.

- The nature of the company meant that different departments had to interact with one another to create in order to produce websites from the client's brief. I was able to effectively communicate my progress and align myself with others.
- Each project had a set deadline. I had to delegate my time to each task and prioritise features for viable releases which we could then pass onto the clients for feedback and improvement.
